- Sustainable spatial development, including water management.
- Environment, energy and climate
- Vital countryside
- Regional accessibility and regional public transport, road safety
- Regional economy
- Cultural infrastructure and preservation
- Quality of public administration

- Public transport authority

On the other hand, concerned residents contribute to knowledge and solutions to issues related to our living environment and health with their own measurements and research.














