

Who hosts #POLIS24: A region, for the first time!

Our host: The Region of Baden-Württemberg

Baden-Württemberg, also known as 'THE LÄND', is the first region to host the Annual POLIS Conference. As a long-standing POLIS member, the region has set ambitious goals, targeting a 55% reduction in emissions from the transport sector by 2030 and striving for carbon neutrality by 2024.

To that end, Baden-Württemberg's Ministry of Transport is implementing concrete measures to reduce car traffic and expand public transport options. It has also invested in innovative cross-border mobility solutions, such as the MobiDatra BW platform.

Besides urban innovations, #POLIS24 will also be an opportunity for Baden-Württemberg to highlight the approach 'Ortsmitte' to rural areas and city surroundings as well as the illustrious sustainable mobility examples of some of its main cities, such as Stuttgart, Heidelberg, and its Annual POLIS Conference 2024's co-host, Karlsruhe.

Our co-host: The City of Karlsruhe

Karlsruhe is renowned for the 'Karlsruhe Model,' featuring a tram-train system, and for its dedicated autonomous driving test area and strong expertise in digital infrastructure.

The city has also earned a reputation as one of the most bikefriendly cities in Europe and has claimed the title of 'Carsharing Capital of Germany.'

Karlsruhe offers a wealth of transport innovations and tourist attractions. Visitors can explore the vibrant Gutenbergplatz market or the <u>Baden State Museum</u>, relax in the Botanical Gardens, or hop on a bike to enjoy <u>Karlsruhe</u>'s <u>cultural and nature cycling tours</u>. Nearby, the Rhine Cycle Route, Rhine Valley Trail, Black Forest Trail, and Stromberg-Murrtal Cycle Route ensure plenty to add to our Conference participants' itinerary!

Other POLIS member in 'THE LÄND': Stuttgart and Heidelberg

The <u>Stuttgart region</u> stands as the geographical, economic, and political heart of Baden-Württemberg. Renowned for its economic prowess and as the birthplace of the automobile, it hosts numerous global players and innovative medium-sized enterprises. The area also boasts stunning landscapes along the Neckar River, where industrial hubs are interspersed with forests, meadows, and vineyards. Moreover, <u>Stuttgart</u> is an ideal destination for leisure and sport cycling and is actively working to enhance its bike-friendliness for commuters!

Heidelberg captivates visitors with its blend of historic architecture and scenic natural landscapes, all easily accessible on foot or by bicycle. Indeed, according to the 2018 nationwide survey 'Mobility in Germany,' 33% of all journeys in the city are made by bike. Moreover, Heidelberg boasts an extensive network of cycle paths totalling 260 kilometres, making it the cycling leader in Baden-Württemberg—the city aims to enhance its appeal to cyclists even further with its 'Bicycle Strategy 2030,' a significant step towards more sustainable mobility.











Our venues: Messe Karlsruhe and ZKM

Our Conference venue: Messe Karlsruhe

Nestled in the vibrant heart of Karlsruhe, the Karlsruhe Trade Fair Centre (Messe Karlsruhe) will serve as the venue of the upcoming Annual POLIS Conference 2024.

Our Conference dinner venue: ZKM


The ZKM | Center for Art and Media Karlsruhe, a cultural institution, was founded in 1989 and, since 1997, is located in a former munitions factory in Karlsruhe, Germany. The ZKM, a pillar in making Karlsruhe a UNESCO Creative City of Media Arts, organises special exhibitions and thematic events, conducts research and produces works on the effects of media, digitisation, and globalisation, and offers public and individualised communications and educational programs.

The ZKM will be the venue for our Conference dinner on 27 November 2024.

Our AGA venue: Gartenhalle POLIS members-only

The Gartenhalle at Karlsruhe Zoo, with its direct access to beautifully landscaped outdoor areas and its bright, open design, provides a delightful atmosphere for any event.

We are excited to announce that the Gartenhalle will host our Annual General Assembly on 26 November 2024. Additionally, POLIS Conference side events, typically held before or after the main Conference and organised by projects or members eager to engage with our gathered participants, will also take place at this venue.



Reaching Karlsruhe

By train

Karlsruhe is well-connected by train to major German cities and neighbouring countries:

- From Berlin: Take an ICE train directly to Karlsruhe. The journey takes about 4-5 hours.
- From Munich: Take an ICE train directly to Karlsruhe. The journey takes about 3-3.5 hours.
- From Paris: Take the TGV or ICE train directly to Karlsruhe. The journey takes about 2.5-3 hours.
- From Brussels: Take an ICE train from Brussels Midi/Zuid to Frankfurt (Main) Hauptbahnhof (Hbf) or Cologne Hbf.
 From there, transfer to an ICE train directly to Karlsruhe.
 The total journey takes about 5-6 hours.
- From London: Take the Eurostar from London St Pancras International to Brussels Midi/Zuid. From Brussels, take an ICE train to Frankfurt (Main) Hauptbahnhof (Hbf) or Cologne Hbf. From there, transfer to an ICE train directly to Karlsruhe. The total journey takes about 6-7 hours.

You can book tickets and check schedules on the <u>Deutsche Bahn</u> website, as well as <u>SNBC International</u>.

By air

From Frankfurt Airport (FRA) - 135 km from Karlsruhe:

- Train: Take an ICE (InterCity Express) train directly from the airport to Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof (main train station).
 The journey takes about 1-1.5 hours.
- Shuttle or buses: Book a transfer from the Airport to Karlsruhe via the A5 highway, which takes about 1.5 hours.
- Car: Drive via the A5 highway, which takes about 1.5 hours

From Stuttgart Airport (STR) - 80 km from Karlsruhe:

- Train: Take an S-Bahn (suburban train) to Stuttgart Hauptbahnhof, then transfer to an ICE or IC (InterCity) train to Karlsruhe. The total journey takes about 1.5-2 hours.
- Shuttle or buses: Book a transfer from the Airport to Karlsruhe via the A8 and A5 highways, which takes about
 115 hours.
- Car: Drive via the A8 and A5 highways, which takes about 1-1.5 hours.

From Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden Airport (FKB) - 40 km from Karlsruhe:

- Bus/Train: Take a bus or taxi to Baden-Baden train station, then a regional train to Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof. The total journey takes about 1 hour.
- Shuttle or buses: Book a transfer from the Airport to Karlsruhe via the A5 highway, which takes about 30-40 minutes.
- Car: Drive via the A5 highway, which takes about 30-40 minutes.

By car

Karlsruhe is easily accessible by major highways:

- Via A5 (Frankfurt-Karlsruhe-Basel) or A8 (Munich-Stuttgart-Karlsruhe): Exit at "Karlsruhe-Mitte" and follow the Südtangente/B10 towards the city.
- Via A65 (Ludwigshafen-Landau-Wörth am Rhein): Follow the highway until before the Wörther Kreuz, where it merges into the Südtangente/B10 towards Karlsruhe.

By long-distance bus

Several long-distance bus companies operate services to Karlsruhe from various European cities. Check companies like <u>FlixBus</u> or <u>Busradar</u> for schedules and tickets.

By KONUS guest card

Travelling within Karlsruhe

Once in Karlsruhe, the city has an efficient public transport system:

- Trams and buses: Operated by the <u>Karlsruhe Transport Authority (KVV)</u>, providing comprehensive coverage of the city and surrounding areas. Please note that participants of the Annual POLIS Conference 2024 can use public transport within the KVV network free of charge from 26 November to 29 November.
- Taxis and ridesharing: Readily available for on-demand transport.

- Language: While many people in Karlsruhe speak English, learning a few basic German phrases can be helpful.
- Currency: Germany uses the Euro (€).

By train and public transport

Participants of the Annual POLIS Conference 2024 can use public transport within the KVV network free of charge from 26 November to 29 November.

From Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof (Main Train Station):

- Take Line 2 (toward Knielingen Nord) or Line 3 (toward Daxlanden) to the Europaplatz Underground stop.
- Change to Line S2 toward Rheinstetten and get off at the Messe/Leichtsandstraße stop.

From the City Centre:

 Take Underground Line S2 toward Rheinstetten and get off at the Messe/Leichtsandstraße stop.

By bus

From Ettlingen:

 Take bus route 106 (direction Neuburgweier Breslauer Str.) directly to Messe Karlsruhe.

From Rastatt:

- Take a bus to the Silberstreifen stop.
- Change to bus route 106 in the direction of Neuburgweier Breslauer Str. and get off at Messe Karlsruhe.

By bike

- Public bicycle and e-bike rental system available at the Messe/Leichtsandstraße tram stop (line S2).
- Hire stations and bike availability can be checked at <u>KVV.nextbike</u>.
- Costs: €1 per 30 min (normal), €2 per 30 min (e-bike).

Distances:

- · Karlsruhe main station: 5.5 km
- · Karlsruhe city centre: 5 km
- Ettlingen city centre: 7 km

By car

- From A5/A8 Motorway: Take exit no. 48 "Karlsruhe-Süd".
- From A65 or B10 Motorway: Take exit no. 8 and follow signs to "Messe".

Parking at Messe Karlsruhe:

- 7,000 car parking spaces in three car parks.
- Parking spaces for people with disabilities are located in the first rows of car park P1.
- E-charging stations are available at the entrance to the administration on car park P1.
- Parking tickets are available for free during the Annual POLIS Conference 2024

Reaching ZKM

By public transport

From Messe Karlsruhe:

- Take line S2 and get off at Europaplatz,
- From Europaplatz take Line 2 (direction ZKM/Hauptbahnhof) and get off at ZKM.

From the City Centre:

 Take line 2 (direction ZKM/Hauptbahnhof) at Europaplatz or Marktplatz (direction ZKM/Knielingen) and get off at 7KM

From Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof (Main Train Station):

Take Line 2 (toward ZKM-Siemensallee) and get off at

By car

From Messe Karlsruhe:

- Drive north on Festplatz towards Messeallee, then merge onto Südtangente/B10 towards Karlsruhe.
- Take the exit towards ZKM and follow signs to ZKM (Lorenzstraße)

From the City Centre:

- Head west on Ettlinger Straße and continue onto Kriegsstraße/B10.
- Turn right onto Lorenzstraße and follow signs to ZKM.







Reaching Gartenhalle

By public transport

From Messe Karlsruhe:

- Take Line S2 (toward Blankenloch or Spöck) and get off at Karlsruhe Marktplatz.
- From Marktplatz (Kaiserstraße), take line S1/11 (direction Hauptbahnhof) or from Marktplatz (Pyramide), take line S4 (direction Hauptbahnhof), S7 (direction Hauptbahnhof), S8 (direction Hauptbahnhof), or 2 (direction Hauptbahnhof) and get off at Kongresszentrum.
- Walk to Gartenhalle, located within the Kongresszentrum complex.

From the City Centre:

- From Marktplatz (Kaiserstraße), take line S1/11 (direction Hauptbahnhof) or from Marktplatz (Pyramide), take line S4 (direction Hauptbahnhof), S7 (direction Hauptbahnhof), S8 (direction Hauptbahnhof), or 2 (direction Hauptbahnhof) and get off at Kongresszentrum.
- Walk to Gartenhalle, located within the Kongresszentrum complex.

From Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof (Main Train Station):

- Take Line 2 (direction Wolfartsweier), S1/11 (direction Hochstetten), S4 (direction Eppingen), S7 (direction Tullastraße), or S8 (direction Tullastraße) and get off at Kongresszentrum.
- Walk to Gartenhalle, located within the Kongresszentrum complex.

By car

From Messe Karlsruhe:

- Drive north on Festplatz towards Messeallee, then merge onto Südtangente/B10 towards Karlsruhe.
- Take the exit towards Kongresszentrum and follow signs for Kongresszentrum/Gartenhalle.

From the City Centre:

- Head south on Ettlinger Straße and turn right onto Festplatz.
- Follow signs to Kongresszentrum/Gartenhalle.

Remember

Gartenhalle is the venue of our Annual General Assembly (AGA) and side events,

For this reason, it is relevant for POLIS members participating in the AGA and side events participants only.
